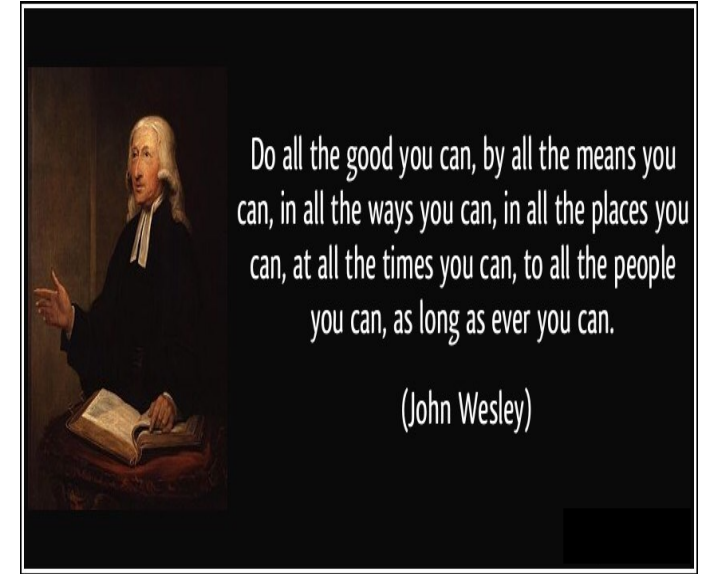
We will be serving the Salvation Army lunch on May 7. Please see Janet Compton if you can help.

Spring soccer has begun, and our U-4 team is practicing and playing. Most games are played Saturday mornings. Schedules can be found on the Narthex table.

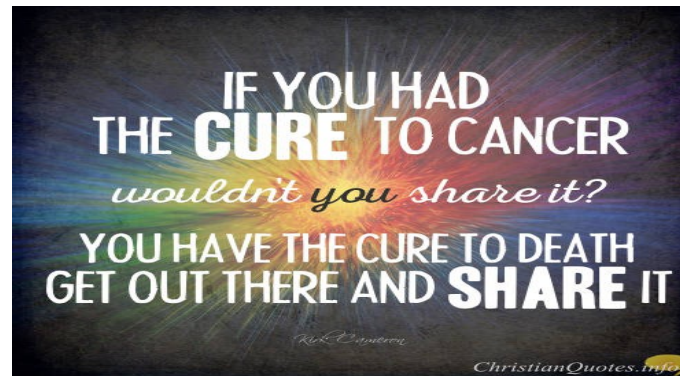
